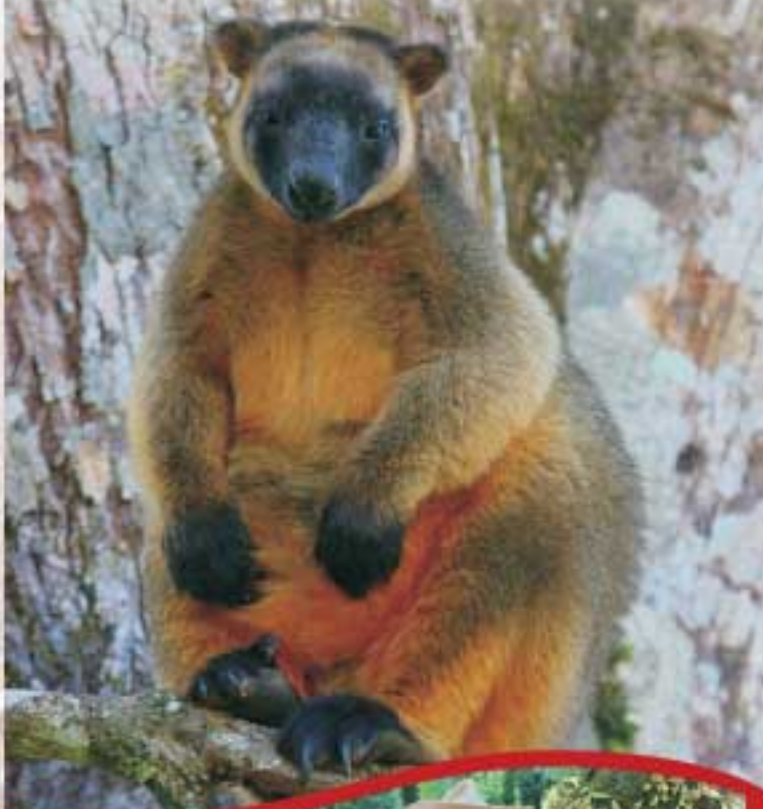
GUIDED WALKS at Malanda Falls

The Conservation Park

Known to the Ngadjon people as Tutamonlin, the Malanda Falls tumble over basalt rocks formed by ancient lava flows. Now the falls and swimming hole below provide a perfect place for family picnics and swimming.

The Malanda Falls Conservation Park is also home to some of Australia's rarer wildlife. Look for Tree-kangaroos, Platypus, or Turtles. Discover the complex rainforest ecosystem— its birdlife, fungi, ferns, vines and rainforest fruits.
